**FEDERAL CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF PAKISTAN HOLDS FULL COURT
MEETING PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF SUMMER VACATION TO REVIEW
INSTITUTIONAL PROGRESS AND FUTURE REFORMS**
