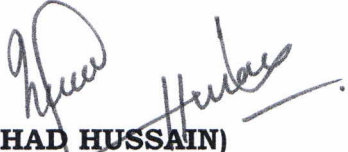
CIRCULAR

In order to facilitate the ongoing process of digitization and development of a secure and efficient digital repository of judicial records of the Federal Constitutional Court of Pakistan, and to ensure digital processing, indexing, preservation and retrieval, as well as its subsequent use in the Court's electronic case management and record systems, all Advocates-on-Record and litigants-in-person are hereby informed that, while instituting cases and applications before the Federal Constitutional Court, the accompanying electronic/scanned copies of the relevant documents shall conform to the following technical specifications:

- i. **Colour scanned copy;**
- ii. **Resolution of 200 DPI; and**
- iii. **Optical Character Recognition (OCR) enabled.**

2. All Advocates-on-Record and litigants-in-person are hereby required to ensure that electronic/scanned copies accompanying cases and applications comply with the aforesaid specifications in letter and spirit with effect from **17.08.2026**.
