Federal Constitutional Court Announces Austerity and Fuel Conservation Measures

In view of the prevailing global and regional situation and the ongoing fuel crisis, the Prime Minister of Pakistan has announced wide-ranging austerity and simplicity measures across the country to promote fuel conservation and responsible use of national resources.

In solidarity with the national effort and in support of the measures announced by the Federal Government, the Federal Constitutional Court of Pakistan, while keeping in view its functional requirements being newly established apex Court of the country, has decided as far as possible to adopt the following austerity and fuel conservation measures:

- i) Maximum Fuel Reduction:**
Maximum reduction of fuel provision for official vehicles in use of the Federal Constitutional Court of Pakistan;
- ii) Four-Day Workweek:**
Observance of a four-day workweek (Monday to Thursday); Friday to Sunday as Holidays.

Through these measures, the Federal Constitutional Court of Pakistan reaffirms its commitment to support national efforts aimed at addressing the current fuel and economic challenges. The Court stands with the nation and the country during this time and will ensure strict implementation of the above noted adopted measures.
