**ECP OFFICER'S VISIT TO THE FEDERAL CONSTITUTIONAL COURT OF PAKISTAN

The interactive session enabled participants to engage with FCCP officials, exchange views, and gain a deeper appreciation of the constitutional responsibilities entrusted to various state institutions and the importance of institutional coordination in promoting good governance.

The visit concluded with a group photograph, followed by the presentation of souvenirs to the Director General, Ms Nighat Siddique, and the Directors of the training programme as a token of appreciation and to commemorate the visit.
