DELEGATION OF MULTAN BAR CALLS ON HON'BLE CHIEF JUSTICE OF FCCP

A thirteen-member delegation of lawyers from the Multan Bar Association called on the Hon'ble Chief Justice of the Federal Constitutional Court of Pakistan, Mr. Justice Amin-ud-Din Khan, at the Court premises.

The visiting lawyers extended a formal invitation to the Hon'ble Chief Justice to visit the Multan Bar Association, which was graciously acknowledged.

As a gesture of respect and cultural goodwill, the delegation presented traditional Ajrak and a Multani topi to the Hon'ble Chief Justice, symbolizing the rich cultural heritage of the region.
